

## CHRISTIAN DANCE FELLOWSHIP OF CANADA CODE OF ETHICS

(see CDFC Constitution for Organization's Purpose, Activities and Basis Of Belief)

### **Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada members** should

- seek to honour Jesus Christ and to build unity in the body of Christ.
- seek excellence and depth in their Christian dance and movement ministry by developing their talents and gifts.
- seek to honour God with their bodies and to assist others in honouring God with their bodies (1Cor. 6:19, Rom. 12:1) in their dance and movement ministry.
- be prepared to accurately represent their training and ability.
- be prepared to accurately communicate the benefits and purpose of their dance presentation or instruction.
- maintain a relationship with a church through worship and fellowship.
- speak for and represent the Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada only if they are elected members of the national or regional committee, referring requests for information about the Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada to the regional or national committee.
- conduct their financial arrangements, concerning the dance and movement ministry using the Biblical principles and ethics and sound business practice.
- comply with copyright law when using recorded music and printed material in his/her ministry.
- when using another's choreography, music or workshop idea either in its original form or in an adapted form, request permission or attribute the choreography or concept to its originator.

### **Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada Committee Members** (national and regional) should

- adhere to CDFC's basis of belief and the members' ethical standards (listed above).
- adhere to all responsibilities of their position as stated in the Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada's constitution.
- seek to uphold the good reputation of the Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada.
- seek to always maintain a high standard for her/his ministry and work in the community, being aware that her/his behaviour represent her/his faith and the Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada.
- seek to cooperate with the national and regional committees of the Christian Dance Fellowship of Canada and their members, adding to instead of disparaging the work of past, present or future committee members.
- ensure that true and accurate records are kept for the Fellowship's national or regional committee.
- keep the confidentiality of those who seek help from them in their role as committee members.
- not enter into business arrangements that could create a conflict of interest between their responsibilities as committee members and their other responsibilities.
